RESOLUTION NO 2011-

Mayor Schreck offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

- 1. The Borough of Bradley Beach shall, according to its ability, supply the Chief of the Division of Fire with a marked vehicle to be used for fire suppression and command and control for any incident involving the Division of Fire. The vehicle shall be equipped with such equipment as is needed for fire suppression and command and control. As owner of the vehicle, the Borough shall set the policy for use of the vehicle.
2. The Chief of The Division of Fire shall be permitted to use the vehicle for incidental personal use within reason for the length of his or her term, to the extent that such use reasonably maximizes his or her availability for fire calls.
3. The Chief of the Division of Fire shall be permitted to use the vehicle for fire suppression and anything associated with fire suppression, including but not limited to attending meetings, field visits, conferences, training, and any other travel needed to carry out the duties of Chief of The Division of Fire.
4. The Chief of the Division of Fire shall maintain mileage records on the vehicle, to document the business and personal use of the vehicle. The Chief shall report the mileage totals annually, and shall make his or her records available for inspection by the Borough Administrator, CFO, or auditor upon request.
5. The Borough of Bradley shall maintain adequate insurance on the vehicle at all times. The Division of Fire shall be financially responsible for repairs to the vehicle.
6. The vehicle shall not be used by anyone other than the Chief of The Division of Fire, except that the Chief Of The Division Of Fire may designate other officers or members of The Division Of Fire, as appropriate, to use the vehicle for designated Division of Fire purposes.
