REPORTS

Councilman Cotler asked Mayor Schreck why she chose not to offer one of the names of individuals who had submitted proposals to the Borough for the position of Borough Attorney. Mayor Schreck responded that in individual conversations with Council that neither of the two individuals were mutually acceptable to herself and the Council and therefore it became necessary to seek additional possibilities for that office. He further asked

if there was an attorney acceptable to Council and not to her. The Mayor responded yes. He responded that she chose to go out and find a new counsel acceptable to her and not necessarily in concert with the Council. She responded that she had. Councilman Cotler then thanked his family and the public for their support. He said that he would like Council to recognize volunteerism, promote fiscal accountability and propose a monthly meeting be held to solve problems throughout the year. He promised to listen to the public and build a better Bradley Beach. Mr. Cotler also announced that Bradley Beach will have entertainment at the Gazebo every night do to the efforts of his wife, Beth and daughter, Samantha. He also announced that the weekly test of the Borough's emergency siren will be changed from Friday at 5PM to Wednesday at 12 Noon.

Councilman D'Angelo expressed some displeasure over the appointment of George McGill as Borough Attorney noting that although he is happy with Mr. McGill he feels Council should have given more consideration to the other two candidates before making a final decision.

Councilman D'Angelo thanked his family for their support as well as the voters. Mr. D'Angelo announced that he will work to bring the town together and institute better policies, mentioned a couple of economical measures which would hopefully reduce taxes within the Borough involving the Board of Education and Public Library. Mr. D'Angelo also recommended an immediate freeze on expenditures and elimination of give away programs. Mr. D'Angelo stated that he is looking forward to working with the Mayor and Council.

Councilman Engelstad thanked his family and supporters. He noted that Council has a lot of challenges facing them in the future and looks forward to working with the Council. Mr. Engelstad encouraged the public to continue attending the council meetings in order that Council can hear their positions and proposals to make Bradley Beach a better place to live.

Councilman Galassetti thanked the voters for returning him to office and his family noting that unfortunately his Mom and Dad are not present. Mr. Galassetti stated that the Council work together to solve problems and should think of ways to generate revenue at the beachfront and on Main Street. He mentioned that his is grateful for the hard work of all the volunteers.

Mayor Schreck congratulated the members of the Council and stated that she looks forward to working with them.
