PROFESSIONAL CONTRACT APPOINTMENTS

WHEREAS, funds are available for this purpose and the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A-11-1 et seq.) required that the resolution authorizing the appointment without competitive bidding must be publicly advertised.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach that:

1. The Borough is hereby authorized and directed to engage the services for a period of one year effective July 1, 2010:
