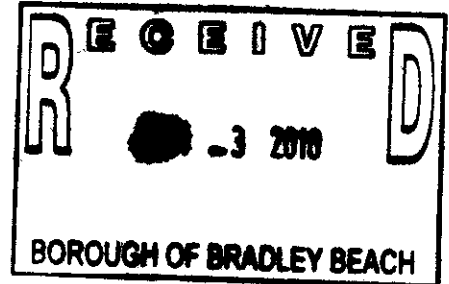

**Thank you for your attention to this matter.**

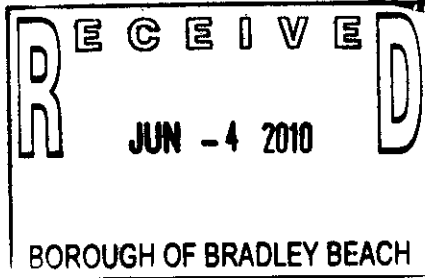

WHEREAS, an estimated tax levy has been computed, at the rate of \$1.230 per \$100.00 of assessed valuation of the 2010 Tax Levy, in accordance with NJSA 54:4-66.3 and the Tax Collector and Chief Financial Officer has signed a certification showing the tax levy for the previous year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 54:4-66.3, the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter estimated bills shall be due by August 10 which is inclusive of the 10 day grace period allowed; and

WHEREAS, any payment received after the 10<sup>th</sup> day of August, shall be subject to interest calculated from the original day that 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter taxes were due (August 1<sup>st</sup>), to the date of payment, in accordance with New Jersey State Statute N.J.S.A. 54:4-66.3.

**WHEREAS**, such resolution of certification shall be adopted by the Governing Body no later than forty-five days after the receipt of the annual audit, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5; and,

**WHEREAS**, all members of the governing body have received and have familiarized themselves with, at least, the minimum requirements of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey, as stated aforesaid and have subscribed to the affidavit, as provided by the Local Finance Board; and

**WHEREAS**, failure to comply with the regulations of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey may subject the members of the local governing body to the penalty provisions of R.S. 52:27BB-52, to wit:

R.S. 52:27BB-52: A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand

dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his office.
